Supervisor Corcoran opened the public hearings for comments. He explained that amending Chapter 145 will allow the Board to include the fees in the fee schedule instead of them being printed in the code and both laws are amending the code to give the Code Enforcement Officer the ability to write certain parking tickets.

There was a brief discussion about the fee schedule, violations, and types of ticketing tools.

Councilwoman Sessa commented that there should be some type of training for the Code Enforcement Officer to limit any safety risks.

Supervisor Corcoran stated that Tom Corcoran has training because he already has to have similar interactions with the public; he agrees that there should be training for future Code Enforcement Officers.

Chief Coccozza briefly explained the ticketing process and what the new tickets will look like.

Councilman Cauchi made a motion to close the public hearings at 7:15 p.m. Motion seconded by Councilman Molinelli.
