Supervisor Corcoran opened the public hearing for comment.

He explained that the change would be that the distance between structures are not less than 15 feet apart if a parcel is 20 acres or more and follows New York State Code.

Mici Simonofsky asked if both fire chiefs are ok with this change and what zone the code pertains to. Supervisor Corcoran stated that both chiefs were notified as well as the Planning Board and Ulster County Planning Board. There have been discussions about one of the fire stations getting a ladder truck without impacting the taxpayers and putting it on the developers as taller structures are built. The code change pertains to multi-family dwellings. Tom Corcoran added that it only pertains to RAg-1 and possibly R-1.

Councilman Cauchi made a motion to close the public hearing at 7:09 p.m. Motion seconded by Councilwoman Sessa.
